Ravenscliff-Roundhill Pet Policy

- 1. All pets must be on a leash and under physical control of a resident when they are outside of a dwelling and must not become a nuisance to other residents.
- 2. Pets causing or creating a nuisance or disturbance may be required to be permanently removed from the property upon ten (10) days prior written notice from the Council (or shorter period as is reasonable if the pet poses a danger to persons).
- 3. No pet owner may walk his or her pet on the private property of any other resident except as provided in easements according to the Declaration.
- 4. Pet owners are responsible for the immediate removal and appropriate sanitary disposal of their pets' solid wastes from anywhere within the Community including the owner's lot.
- 5. Pet owners are responsible for any property damage, injury or disturbance caused by their pets.
- 6. No exterior animal shelter structures, dog run or overhead cables for the attachment of an animal chain or lead shall be permitted.
